SYNOPSIS OF THE CASE

Respondent 1 in this Writ Petition, is already in receipt of annexure A court orders, and recognize the cause of action and the legal resolution of the 'cause of action', breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty committed by united states patent and trademark office, US PTO, on 5-8-2015, with reference of invention my patent rights recognized PCT/us2014/046619. The breached Patent Cooperation Treaty is signed by 158 World countries, including India, and hence the legal resolution is by the court orders for execution of 62 sale agreements. With me, the applicant according to PCT article 9(1), this 'cause of action' will conclude by way of the execution of 62 sale agreements, one each with 62 World countries. I am bringing wealth through the 62 sale agreements, from the sale of my 'Invention Systems and Methods, patent rights', and will be building INDIA National Treasury and all the State Treasuries, along with Union Territory Treasuries, the wealth distribution is indicated in Annexure D, the most recent Living Will Addendum executed on 29-12-

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2024, and the attached supporting documents of annexure D. I am the 'Seller' of 'my invention patent rights', the wealth from the sale to be deposited into my 'Individual bank account', in the yet to be established ITB Bank India, International Trade and Business Bank INDIA, wherein the wealth must be deposited in a 'World neutral currency EARTHLINGS'. read details about Earthlings, at my https://ProjectEarthling.com. The details of the 62 sale agreements are in annexure T. I have outlined a 'Four years Macro Program projected events timeline', which must be considered with minimal schedule variance, from the start of the 'Original Suit' proceeding, for the conclusion of the execution of these 62 sale agreements, by the orders of the Honorable court. I will distribute the wealth according to Annexure D, Living Will executed on 22-8-2022, and while doing so, I will take up the role of 'MET Counsellor, Macro Economic Transformations Counsellor', and will be heading the Elite organization of INDIA, 'INDIA ECONOMIC COUNCIL', and will also provide Macro Guidance for INDIA, all of INDIA to achieve 'Goal Year 2050 for INDIA', also referred as 'Goal Year 30 FE for INDIA', wherein FE stands for 'Freedom by Earthling' years. The work involves 'Initiating and executing' a series a 'Transformative Initiatives', including IEC'S ADVISORY role for INDIA Central, and State Governments. The Economic advise will include providing annual, and political term ADVISORY GUIDANCE to Prime Minister, Central Government cabinet of Ministers, all the State Chief Ministers, and their cabinet of Ministers. Guidance for Union Territories is implied. In the decentralized World, every country citizen will cherish and live 'Fearless Nationalism', and 'Fearless Patriotism'. While 'Fearless Nationalism', and 'Fearless Patriotism' are inherent within a person, and are not governed by 'articles in constitution alone', I indicate that with the execution of 62 sale agreements, and building our National, State, UT treasuries, and guiding INDIA to achieve our economic objectives, I am performing my Fundamental Duties for my country, according to article 51A, of the constitution of INDIA. The applicable articles of 51A, include article 51A(d), with reference of 'render national service...', 51A(g), 51A(h), with reference of 'reform;...', and 51A(j), with reference of 'collective activity so that the nation rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement....'. My commitment for my country is unwavering and the same will transcend for all INDIA citizens living in INDIA, and that are HINDUTVA by religion. The Honorable court must issue necessary orders to Respondent 2 and Respondent 3, for deferring

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the Income tax and GST, against my legally pledged and executed contribution in annexure D, to Respondent 2, Commissioner of Income Tax Department, and conclude the book keeping upon my payment of the first set of checks payable to recipients listed in annexure D. I request Respondents 2 and 3 to keep record of pending Income tax, and GST respectively, and apply necessary fees, charges, penalties, and interest, all of which must be offset against my payment of first check to Commissioner of Income Tax Department, 20% pledged pay, according to annexure D. Also issue orders for Respondent 4, to generate and issue property payment receipts including my name, and reflecting my name accurately. Given the wealth that I would bring to INDIA, Honorable court must TERMINATE if they become aware, or come to know of attempts of 'Identity theft' of my identification, and attempts of 'aliases' who are attempting to steal my work, or steal my wealth. Recording all my identification documents issued by authorities in INDIA, with accurate information, will ensure all attempts of 'Identity theft' are terminated.

CHRONOLOGICAL SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

The chronological sequence of events relevant to this writ petition are listed here.

1. 15-7-2014 PCT International application

PCT/us2014/046619 was filed with US PTO as Receiving office and International Searching Authority, ISA, for my invention 'Systems and Methods for altering the color, appearance, or feel of a vehicle surface', taking priority of priority patent application filed with US PTO 14/227,859, filed on 27-3-2014, which is a patent grant 'us 8,910,998 B1' with patent date of 16-12-2014. The PCT International application is an exact replica of the priority application, the patent grant. With PCT/us2014/046619, I have filed a total of 15 National applications, and 2 Regional applications, seeking protection of my 'Invention systems and methods' patent rights across 61 World countries.

- 2. 16-12-2014 Priority Patent granted in my name by US PTO, with patent number US 8,910,998 B1.
- 3. 5-8-2015 US PTO, in their capacity of ISA, commit breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty articles 18(2), and 19(1), for my patent invention recognized accross PCT contracting states, PCT/us2014/046619. This 'Breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty' is already recognized by this Honorable court with documented evidence, reflected in court orders dated 14-6-2024, for WP 12356/2024, attached as annexure A.
- 4. 24-2-2016 PCT International applications
 PCT/IB2016/050993, PCT/IB2016/050994, and
 PCT/IB2016/050995 are filed with International
 Bureau, IB as Receiving office and Intellectual
 Property India, IPI, as the International Searching
 Authority, ISA. These are other sector 'Industrial
 applications' of my 'Invention systems and
 methods', including the exemplary Thermal
 Insulation, Construction Industrial application.

By way of the established International Search Reports, ISR'S for these other sector 'Industrial applications', they are my patent rights across the 62 World countries.

- 5. 2019-2020 Full liability caused to US PTO for issuing the fabricated ISR, for loss of my 'Invention systems and methods' patent rights, across 60 World countries. The details are included in annexure B.
- 6. 14-6-2024 High court of Karnataka issues orders, attached annexure A, recognizing the 'Breach of PCT, committed by US PTO', with full documented evidence and facts. I attach a table listing all National and Regional stage applications and liability caused dates, as annexure B.

I am National of India, and permanent resident in India, with my residential address indicated in Form B enclosures, copies of my INDIA passport No. Z6387411, issued on 11-11-2021. These set of events are connected with my 'Income tax filings', in India, since the caused liability proceeds will be paid into my 'Individual bank account' in India, according to the details of 62 sale agreements in attached annexure T.

The extremely high valued 'Patent rights, Intellectual property rights' in my name, are connected to my tax filings in INDIA. I request the respondents to read annexure D in detail, and annexure B in detail, further with consideration of article 51A provisions of constitution of India, to fully understand my intended work, and contribution for India and religion of Hinduism.

Including the details of Intellectual property patent rights PCT/us2014/046619 registered in my name, in this Writ Petition, I present the full details of the other properties registered in my name, my income from these other properties by financial year, with full fact set placed on record with this Honorable court, and respondents. Here, I present the details of my income summary from other properties in a sentence by financial years, FY, starting with FY 2020-2021.

For FY 2020 - 2021 My income from leasing the property referred in annexure H, and annexure J, according to Lease agreements referred in annexure K, was remitted by the lessee, with 10% TDS deducted at source.

For FY 2021 - 2022 Mutatis mutandis same as FY 2020 - 2021. Rental remittance received from lessee with 10% TDS deducted at source.

For FY 2022 - 2023 With GST number becoming mandatory requirement, rental payment was not issued by lessee for this FY. I received my GST registration certificate and number on 21-2-2024.

For FY 2023 - 2024 After receipt of the GST registration certificate and number, the rental payment for this FY and the preceeding FY, were remitted to me by the lessee. 20% TDS was deducted at source.

All of these FY tax filings are connected with the 'legal resolution of the cause of action, Breach of PCT', and the wealth proceeds which must be received by me from the execution of the 62 sale agreements described in detail in Annexure T. In annexure B, I indicate the liability caused to US PTO, by 'Patent territory', with 'Lost patent serial numbers', with conservative sale price valuation, and liability caused dates, all of which must be recognized as my patent wealth and income, with patent an 'asset' in INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY asset class, according to Patent Cooperation Treaty. This recognized patent wealth and income for loss of my patent rights, and intellectual property rights' was caused, is indicated in annexure B, and are connected with annexure D, Living Will executed on 22-8-2022, along with all the attached supporting documents. The full wealth payable to me, into my bank account in INDIA, is from the execution of the 62 sale agreements described in detail in Annexure T, with legal references to attached annexure A, Honorable court orders, and annexure B indicating the caused liability dates by each Patent territory.

According to annexure D wealth allocation, respondent 2 is recipient of 20% of the full wealth I bring into my bank account in INDIA. While GST payments are considered 'Indirect taxes' and respondent 3 are made separate party from respondent 2, given that they are divisions within the same ministry, my 20% contribution for 'Commissioner of Income tax department' respondent 2, must be used as source contribution for pending GST payments for respondent 3. Further, respondent 3 has all India States and Union Territories representation in their division. I refer to this legal statement, by citing my individual state contributions, a 15% of the total wealth distributed across all States and UT'S across India, in proportion of the population. With attempts of 'Identity theft', and usage of 'aliases' against me by US PTO, I request respondent 4, for issuing receipts for the 'Property tax' with my name included and accurately reflected.

Since the wealth receipts from the 62 sale agreements, considered 'recognized patent wealth and income according to Patent Cooperation Treaty' is connected with my income tax returns, and hence with the execution of 62 sale agreements. For these facts, the Honorable court must grant of Interim prayer orders, and prayer orders in this Writ Petition, and

this Writ Petition be connected with the case for execution of 62 sale agreements listed in annexure S, and described in detail in annexure T.

My income tax dues payable from the rental income proceeds, from annexure K, from non intellectual other properties, after applying the TDS deductions, generally result in nominal balance due, or in some years a refund from respondent 2.

With reference to orders issued by the Honorable court for Writ Petition WP 12356/2023, dated 14-6-2024, attached annexure A, and the legal resolution of the recognized 'cause of action', the Breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty committed by 'united states patent and trademark office', US PTO; by way of execution of 62 sale agreements described in detail in annexure T, the caused liability to US PTO in Trillions of EARTHLINGS, liability caused by patent territories with liability dates listed in annexure B, full value payable into my individual bank account in INDIA, according to PCT article 9(1), and with reference of my responsibly and legally pledged 'wealth allocation' according to annexure D, by 'granted patent rights', 'us 8,910,998 B1', PCT/us2014/046619, valuation', caused liability, connected with my tax filings, the Honorable court must issue the orders prayed in this Writ Petition immediately.

MEMORANDUM OF WRIT PETITION UNDER ARTICLES 51A, 226 AND 227 OF CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, CONNECTED WITH BREACH OF PATENT COOPERATION TREATY COMMITTED BY UNITED STATES PATENT AND TRADEMARK OFFICE, ON 5-8-2015, FOR MY INVENTION PATENT RIGHTS FOR PCT/US2014/046619.

FACTS OF THE CASE

- 1. My permanent residential address, also indicated in my passport, NATIONAL and citizenship identification, 63, 11th B cross, 3rd Main, Prashanthnagar, Bengaluru 560079, INDIA, the house was registered in the name of my father Mr. D. Satyanarayana, and upon his death on 1-1-2018, it is registered in my mothers name Mrs. D.S. Premaleela. This shall remain my residential address for all postal communications until the conclusion of the execution of 62 sale agreements, if such communication is even required, since I will be physically present in the Honorable court for all court hearings and receiving court orders, until the conclusion of the 'cause of action'.
- 2. While I have served notice and summons of the Writ Petition for respondent 1 and respondent 3, I will issue notice and summons for

respondent 2, and respondent 4 upon court orders for notice. With reference to urgency of 'continuously receiving the monthly lease rental income, without interruptions', immediately enabling the lessee in annexure K to remit rent, remit the past rental dues, and continue to remit the rent, the Honorable court must issue the 'Interim prayer orders immediately'.

- 3. Due to the situation of 'Impugned orders', and past Writ Appeals, since High court of Karnataka started allowing Appellate Jurisdiction hearings, this Writ Petition must be heard by Single Judge or a bench where the Justices are other than Justice K.S. Mudagal, Justice M.G.S. Kamal, and Justice C.M. Joshi.
- 4. Patent Cooperation Treaty article 18(2) reads, 'The international search report shall, as soon as it has been established, be transmitted by the International Searching Authority to the applicant and the International Bureau.'
- 5. United States Patent and Trademark office breached PCT articles 18(2) and 19(1), on 5-8-2015, already recognized by the Honorable court with documented evidence and facts, indicated in the Honorable court orders for Writ Petition WP 12356/2023 dated 14-6-2024, attached as annexure A with this Writ petition, are certified copy of the court orders.
- 6. Patent Cooperation Treaty article 19(1) reads, 'The applicant shall, after having received the international search report, be entitled to one opportunity to amend the claims of the international application by filing amendments with the International Bureau within the prescribed time limit. ...'.
- 7. Patent Cooperation Treaty article 9(1) reads, 'Any resident or national of a Contracting State may file an international application.'
- 8. I am a national of INDIA, by birth, and a permanent resident of INDIA, at the address mentioned in the cause title. Included in Form B enclosure, are copies of my INDIA passport No. Z6387411, issued on 11-11-2021, for my address and photo identification. India is one of the contracting states of the Treaty. Given these facts, the caused liability to US PTO, is payable into my 'Individual' bank account in India, at ITB Bank, International Trade and Business Bank India, yet to be organized, according to 62 sale agreements described in detail in annexure T.

- 9. Article 51A of constitution of India, 'Fundamental Duties', among which the articles relevant for this writ petition read,
 - '...(d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;...
 - (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life, and to have compassion for living creatures;
 - (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism, and the spirit of inquiry and reform;....
 - (j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement....'
- 10. I am performing my Fundamental duties for my country, and my religion of HINDUISM, the majority population of the country, according to article 51A of constitution of India.
- 11. Performing my 'Fundamental duties for my country', render national service, I have pledged a total of 90% of the wealth proceeds I bring to INDIA into my bank account, for the visionary goal of 'Goal year 2050 for INDIA, ensuring India achieves all its economic objectives, and becomes an economic super power, with the National, State, and Union Territory treasuries built, largest in the World, and managed by me, MET Counsellor, Macro Economic Transformations Counsellor, of INDIA ECONOMIC COUNCIL, IEC, an INDIA council that will protect the long term, spanning decades, and centuries, interests of INDIA, and religion of HINDUISM, majority population of India. Goal year 2050 for INDIA, is also referred as 'Goal year 30 FE for INDIA', FE stands for Freedom by Earthling years. The pledged wealth contributions are indicated in annexure D. I attach the following with Annexure D,
 - My Living Will executed on 22-8-2022, with enclosures.
 - Living Will addendum executed on 29-12-2024, with enclosure.
 - The 'Wealth distribution within INDIA, according to the executed Living Will'.
 - Introductory brochure about 'Cascading effects of my work for achieving 'Goal year 2050 for INDIA', also referred as 'Goal year 30 FE for INDIA', to all the World countries.

- Supporting document to the Living will executed on 22-8-2022. A copy of the aadhaar card of my mother Mrs. D. S. Premaleela, who is in receipt of a copy of the 'Living will executed on 22-8-2022'.
- Legal supporting document to the Living will executed on 22-8-2022. Certified copy of the Divorce decree indicating 'date of disposal 25-7-2012', and one time full and final settlement 'Mediation report', from Family court at Bangalore, for M. C. No. 1014/2011, concluding my divorce with Smt. Vindhya Yalmuri.
- Legal supporting document to the Living will executed on 22-8-2022. Electronic legal communication sent to my siblings, sisters Mrs. Sridevi Devathi, and Mrs. Shirisha Mohan, on 23-2-2024.
- 12. CPC section 151, Saving the inherent powers of courts, reads, 'Nothing in this code shall be deemed to limit or otherwise affect the inherent power of the court to make such orders as may be necessary for ends of justice...'.
- Treaty, for ensuring the legal agreement signed by 158 World countries is enforced, where applicable and essential must exercise CPC section 151. The Honorable court must exercise CPC section 151, wherever they deem it applicable, and essential, for the prayer points in this Writ Petition.
- 14. I attach my State Bank of India savings bank account, account number 10140975802 bank statements, from 1-4-2020 through 31-3-2025, as annexure C, showing the rental income remittances from the lessee occupying the leased premises, the lease agreements attached as annexure K. This is for declaring my income during this period for the Honorable court, from the properties I own in India, and the one source of income from tenancy of the commercial property owned by me, which are 'properties other than the patents registered in my name, my intellectual properties spanning 62 World countries'.
- 15. The Breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty, PCT, committed by US PTO with reference of my invention patent rights for

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PCT/us2014/046619, is recognized by the Honorable court and the orders issued for WP 12356/2023, dated 14-6-2024, are attached as annexure A. Details of 'my recognized patent wealth and income', with patent an 'asset' in INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY asset class, are in attached annexure B, indicating Patent territory, lost patent serial number, conservative sale price valuation, and caused liability dates. I include technical details of Thermal Insulation Industrial application for Construction Industry with annexure B, which is a must read for the Honorable court and the respondents.

The full legal conclusion of the recognized 'cause of action', 16. Breach of PCT is by way of Honorable court orders, for getting the 62 sale agreements listed in annexure S, and described in detail in annexure T executed, at the Honorable court. These 62 sale agreements are agreements, one each with each of the 62 World countries, signed by the 62 World country Leaders, recipients of their territory 'Invention patent rights including all Industrial application sectors' and with me, the Seller of the 'Patent and Intellectual property rights'. The full details of these 62 sale agreements are in annexure T. With this wealth already registered and wealth pending receipt in my bank account in India, my individual bank account at ITB Bank India, International Trade and Business Bank India, which is yet to be organized, I have responsibly, assigned, allocated, the wealth according to article 51A of constitution of India, by executing my Living Will with reference to these invention patent rights, on 22-8-2022, included with annexure D. I request the respondents to read annexure T, and annexure D in great detail, to recognize the responsible allocation of wealth registered and that must be received by me.

It was executed with a POA document by my father Mr. D. Satyanarayana, resulting in my ownership of 25% of the two floors. The 'Power of Attorney' document executed on 1-1-2009 is included in annexure H. The parties connected in the agreement are Smt. R. Padma Devi, M/S Sri sadhguru shelters represented by T. Anuradha, Me, Smt. Vindhya Yalmuri, represented by D. Satyanarayana using the POA only for the execution of this agreement since I was outside India at the time, and N.S. Ram Mohan and his legal heirs.

Annexure J, is a copy of property ownership 'release deed' executed by Smt. Vindhya Yalmuri, on date 25-7-2012, resulting in my ownership share of 50% of the two floors. Parties connected in the agreement include Me, and Smt. Vindhya Yalmuri.

- 23. In annexure D, I pledge 20% of the full value payable to respondent 2, and with respondent 3 being part of the same ministry, my prayer is to offset the pending dues according to the prayer sought, upon my payment of the first set of checks for recipients in annexure D.
- 24. For these reasons, the Honorable court must grant the interim prayer orders, and prayer orders immediately. For book keeping and offsetting the dues, I will file one memo for each FY, where I attach the most recent addendum executed which is about income receipts from properties in table 5, and the income receipts summary from properties listed in table 1.
- 25. With the caused liability to US PTO, my patent wealth and income according to annexure B, the income from table 5 and table 1 are combined for the consideration of Ministry of Finance since FY 2020-2021, the caused liability to US PTO already recognized by the Honorable court orders, attached annexure A. I attach annexure M,

which include electronic communication for recipients of wealth listed in the Living Will executed on 22-8-2022, of annexure D, in which I have proactively informed them about annexure A, list of 62 sale agreements, and the Living Will addendum for end of year 2024, for those where e-mail ID'S were available.

- 26. Similarly, I attach annexure N, in which I have proactively requested respondent 2, to inform respondent 3, since they are within the same ministry, and respondent 3 has representation of all States and Union Territories of India, while they do not accept e-mail communications.
- 27. Notice received from respondent 2 and my response to their notice are attached as annexures Q and R, respectively. Annexure Q includes E-verification notice from respondent 2, for FY 2021-2022, issued on date 1-7-2024.
 - Annexure R includes the E-verification response acknowledgement filed by me on 9-7-2024 with respondent 2, for E-verification notice dated 1-7-2024, answering the E-verification questions of respondent 2, which includes information about the Living Will, and a Writ Appeal which would be a different case, for executing 62 sale agreements. With annexure R, I also include 7 E-verification response acknowledgements of my response to respondent 2.
- Applicable property tax for the commercial property, property A in table 1, is payable for respondent 4, Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike. 30. With reference to Identifications, Aadhar project through the forced and applied levers, resulted in the data center storing the Aadhar database to be in rouge usa. This has compromised all our country citizen data, personal information, data in their control, is life in their control, and allows them to impose external cage, and use data lever. The give away of our country data has allowed US PTO, rouge usa to impose all forms of levers and control on our country, and attack, target, with singular agenda of destroying and terminating the religion of Hinduism. India Economic Council, IEC will build our technology systems on our platforms, including the data centers designed and built in the safety of our own technology platforms, physically located in our territory, INDIA, ensuring our country data, our citizen data, are highly secure, and ensuring the full safety of citizen information, and that of religion of Hinduism.

CAUSE OF ACTION.

31. The recognized 'cause of action' according to Honorable court orders for WP 12356/2023, dated 14-6-2024, annexure A, recognizing the 'Breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty' committed by united states patent and trademark office, US PTO.

32. This Writ Petition is connected with the 'patent rights sale wealth' that I will receive from the legal resolution of the 'cause of action'. Hence, this Writ Petition after granting orders must be connected with case for execution of 62 sale agreements.

Neutralizing and terminating negative tactics.

- 33. Terminating negative tactics of US PTO and their allies, that are attempting 'Identity theft', and using 'aliases'.
 - a. With reference of PCT article 9(1), me, National of INDIA, with permanent residential address in Bengaluru, INDIA, must receive all wealth proceeds from 62 sale agreements into my bank account in INDIA. Recording and registering my 'Identification', National of INDIA, and 'Applicant' according to Patent Cooperation Treaty article 9(1), accurately, will terminate attempts of 'Identity theft', and attempts of 'aliases', for fraudulently representing me, to steal my work, and steal my wealth. US PTO breached a TREATY signed by 158 World countries. They are attempting to steal this wealth, or block this wealth from coming to me at 'World stage', in front of all 158 World countries, and 193 World countries. I indicate that the negative tactics, illegal tactics, example, by stating lies, stating never occured stories, using fabricated photos, and using fabricated videos, all in the attempts of 'Identity theft', and being an 'alias' of me, to illegally claim my work, and illegally steal my wealth, are attempted, by using rouge puppet old world order, attempts made in front of all World countries. Such attempts must be terminated, by proactively neutralizing all their negative tactics, so that I bring the full wealth into INDIA, into my bank account in INDIA. With reference to extremely high valued patents of mine, valuation with liability dates listed in annexure B, here are my LEGAL STATEMENTS, with reference to WORLD, 192 other World countries, other than INDIA, and country of my Nationality, INDIA, for terminating all negative tactic attempts of 'Identity theft' and becoming 'aliases' for me, to steal my work, and steal my wealth, so that the Honorable court could TERMINATE such illegal negative attempts, if they come to recognize such negative tactics, or become aware of such negative tactics.

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Neutralizing 'Identity theft', and creating 'aliases' at multitude of levels.

b. US PTO and their allies, my public enemies, have used 'Identity theft', and creating 'aliases' for me at a multitude of levels, all of which must be terminated. The following are my legal statements related to these negative tactics, which must be terminated by way of legal investigation and court orders, so that we move into the stage of execution of 62 sale agreements.

For WORLD.

c. I am National of INDIA, with reference to Patent Cooperation Treaty article 9(1), and hence no citizen, no person, no party, no organization, no company, no corporation, no Leader, no king, no queen, no Government, no college, and no university, from across 192 other World countries can represent me, and attempt to use 'Identity theft', and attempts of becoming 'aliases' for me, to steal my work, and steal my wealth. This includes white house, its inhabitants, past and present presidents of rouge usa, their family members, and legal heirs, who cannot represent me, who cannot become my alias, to steal my wealth, and steal my work, for example Project Earthling©. This also includes royal families, kings, queens, their family members, and their legal heirs, of rouge uk, and rouge usa, example inhabitants of buckingham palace, their families, and legal heirs, who cannot represent me, who cannot become alias for me, to steal my work, and steal my wealth.

For INDIA.

d. Legal statements for the record of the Honorable court. Given the conservative valuation of my granted patent rights listed in table 5, across 62 World countries, recognized by PCT/us2014/046619, PCT/IB2016/050993, PCT/IB2016/050994, and PCT/IB2016/050995, combined sale of 'all Industrial sector applications', also indicated in my website webpage https://srinivasdevathi.in/, set at 93 Trillion EARTHLINGS, and reference of annexure B, within INDIA, several people, parties that networked with US PTO or their

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allies, and received rouge bribes, rouge commands by usage and imposing of levers, have attempted to commit 'Identity theft', become an 'alias' for me, fraudulently steal my work, and steal my wealth. With reference of Patent Cooperation Treaty article 9(1),

- Government of India, Union of India, Ministry of External Affairs, Legal & Treaties Division, cannot represent me.
- Government of India, Union of India, Ministry of Finance, Income tax department, cannot represent me.
- Government of India, Union of India, Ministry of Finance, Central Board of Indirect taxes and customs headquarters, cannot represent me.
- State Government of Karnataka, cannot represent me.
- Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike, respondent 4, cannot represent me.
- The respondents 1, 2, 3, and 4 in this Writ Petition cannot represent me.
- People that are party to these agreements, and deeds, listed in tables 1 and 2, cannot represent me.
- State Bank of India cannot represent me.
- The authorities within India, that issued my Identification documents, including those listed in table 6, cannot represent me. The authorities that issued my ID'S are forced, bribed to distort my ID documents, and they must avoid such ID misrepresentation, and cannot represent me. For example, Transport Department, State Government of Karnataka.
- e. For INDIA, the extended list of people, parties, organizations, governing authority, that cannot represent me include,
 - State Bank of India, their employees past and present, including all their legal heirs.
 - My parents Late D. Satyanarayana, and Mrs. D.S. Premaleela.
 - My sisters Mrs. Sridevi Devathi, and Mrs. Shirisha Mohan, including all their legal heirs.
 - Bangalore university, all their alumni, including all their professors, including all their legal heirs.

- VTU, Sir M. Vishveshwarayya Technology University, all their alumni, including all their professors, including all their legal heirs.
- RVCE, all their alumni, including all their professors, including all their legal heirs.
- Osmania university, all their alumni, including all their professors, including all their legal heirs.
- Madras university, all their alumni, including all their professors, including all their legal heirs.
- Delhi university, all their alumni, including all their professors, including all their legal heirs.
- Divorsed wife Smt. Vindhya Yalmuri, her family relatives, including B.S. ravindranath, including all their legal heirs.
- M/S Sadguru shelters, and their legal heirs.
- N. S. Rama mohan, N. R. Lakshmi kalyani, N.R. Vinutha, and N.R. Manish, including all their legal heirs.
- Entire film industry in India and abroad, including every one affiliated with it, including their legal heirs.
- Doctors across India, including their legal heirs. Hospitals across India, including their legal heirs.
- Police department across India, all police, including their legal heirs. In this context, all India State Governments, and India Central Government including their legal heirs.
- Lawyers, and advocates across India, including their legal heirs.
- Law firms across India, including their legal heirs.
- All Judicial courts in India, including city civil courts, High courts of all States, Supreme court of India, and all forms of Judicial courts across India, including their legal heirs.
- All India Judiciary, including all the Chief Justices of States, and Chief Justice of India, including their legal heirs.
- All Ministers, and Leaders of India, including Prime Minister, Chief Ministers of all States, President of India, and Leaders of Union Territories, including their offices, and including their legal heirs.
- India billionaires that were listed on most recent list, a listing in defunct currency in rouge usd currency, their family members and their legal heirs, cannot represent me.

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EARTHLINGS COUNCIL will publish brand new 'Billionaires list' in EARTHLINGS currency, audited and verified, by each country.

- Bennett and coleman Ltd, Times Group cannot represent me.
- Wodeyar, mysore king, controlled and commanded from rouge usa and rouge uk, including all his surviving family and all their legal heirs.
- Deccan Herald, Mysore printers Pvt Ltd., including their legal heirs.
- MES college, all their alumni, including all professors, including their legal heirs.
- Mysore silks Pvt Ltd., including their legal heirs.
- Mysore soap factory Pvt Ltd., including all their legal heirs.
- Kotejoshyer srinivasan, Kotejoshyer badari, K.s. rajashree, including their legal heirs.
- Pappur manjunath, Sangeetha, including their legal heirs.
- Govinahalli nagendra, G. N. karthik, Sapna manjunath, including their legal heirs.

Honorable court must TERMINATE such illegal negative attempts, if they come to recognize such negative tactics, or become aware of such negative tactics.

f. According to PCT article 9(1), all the wealth from table 5 properties is payable only into my bank account in INDIA. Given this fact, the Honorable court must dismiss all the 'driven by exorbitant bribes' attempts to buy out people, parties, authorities, and possibly governing organizations, to go against me, or attempt to frame me. The Honorable court must dismiss all such attempts of framing me, and their negative tactics. In this section, I list the possible people, parties, authorities, and possibly governing organizations, who might have come under pressure, force, threat, and possible attack of rouge US PTO, and rouge usa, by way of issuing threats, bribes in monopolized rouge usd currency, issuing rouge orders, illegal orders, verbal promises, verbal threats, applying financial lever of bribing, business lever, trade lever, political lever, economic lever, not limited to and including data

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center lever, and all forms of advanced technology levers, including usage of serum package poisons against our country Leaders, and exercizing exorbitantly high amounts of doled out bribes, all of this, for getting people, parties, authorities, and possibly governing organizations, to frame me negatively, by stating lies, stating never occured stories, using fabricated photos, and using fabricated videos, all in an attempt of 'Identity theft', and being an 'alias' of me, to illegally claim my work, and illegally steal my wealth.

i. Agreements listed in tables 1 and 2.

- With reference of table 1, and table 2, and referring to column '.....parties connected in the agreement', the usage of all forms of bribes, financial lever, all other possible levers, or exorbitant amounts of bribes offered, the following people, parties connected to the agreements could, or might have attempted to frame me negatively, to steal my work, and steal my wealth, by usage of negative tactics 'Identity theft', and becoming an 'alias'. These people, parties include,
- Smt. R. Padma Devi and her legal heirs, M/S Sri sadhguru shelters represented by T. Anuradha and her legal heirs, and N.S. Ram Mohan and his legal heirs.
- Smt. Vindhya Yalmuri and her legal heirs.
- B.S. Ravindranath and his legal heirs.
- State Bank of India and their legal heirs, and N.S. Rama Mohan and his legal heirs.

ii. <u>Legal agreements cannot be used as a tool to target or frame a person.</u>

- People, and parties connected with these legal agreements are plain simply bound by the contents of the legal agreements, however, it seems that some of these people, and parties have attempted to leverage, and use the legal agreement, or the legal instrument, as a tool, mechanism, rouge method, or rouge approach to frame me negatively.

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These are negative tactics attempted by my public enemy US PTO, and the Honorable court must dismiss all such negative tactics attempted by people, and parties connected with these legal agreements, if they become aware or recognize such attempts.

- Attempts to use legal agreement, property document, lease agreement, against one of the party in the agreement is illogical and illegal.
- The agreement is worth what is written in the agreement, and not for usage against other parties by bribe taking party.
- All such negative tactics used or attempted by US PTO must be dismissed by the Honorable court, as they conflict with the 'legal agreements' and what the legal agreements stand for. The Honorable court must dismiss all such frivolous negative tactics used by parties, including all their legal heirs, connected with the legal agreements listed in tables 1, and 2, by taking bribes and forging fraudulent alliances with US PTO.

iii. My ID'S and possible usage of them against me.

With reference to my Identifications listed in table 6, there is a possibility that US PTO, in the rouge old world order attempted all possible negative levers, negative tactics, usage of 'exorbitant bribes', usage of political lever, trade lever, financial lever, economic lever, data center lever, advanced technology lever, and most dangerous serum technology poisoning at these authorities, and the Leaders heading these authorities, to issue ID'S with errors, or use the issued ID for framing me negatively, for forcing usage of 'Identity theft' and placing 'aliases' in my place, to steal my work, steal my wealth, the wealth receipts I must receive from properties listed in table 5, and such attempts at a World level. In this context, I indicate that authorities issuing the ID'S were possibly used to frame me negatively. With reference

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to article 9(1) of PCT, the Honorable court must dismiss such attempts of the authorities that issued the ID'S for me, while using the ID to frame me, and creating an 'alias' for me, and illegally steal my wealth and my work.

- iv. I also indicate there is a possibility of attempts of 'Identity theft', or usage of 'alias' by connected registering and governing authorities connected with legal agreements listed in table 1. For example, the property B, in Pedda Shapur village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, the legal agreement could be used as a tool to replace me, become an 'alias' for me, attempt identity theft by RR district muncipal authority, Hyderabad muncipal authority, or State Government of Telangana. Such attempts must be dismissed by the Honorable court.
 - Mutatis mutandis for legal agreements executed in Bengaluru, respondent 4, BBMP, State Government of Karnataka, possibly representing the princely state of Mysore, any residual documentation of them used against me must be dismissed. I draw the attention of the Honorable court to the fact that since my place of birth is Bengaluru, permanent residential address is in Bengaluru, the frivolous attempts, usage of 'exorbitant bribes' were highest in the city of Bengaluru, where respondent 4 is a local authority, and for the State Government of Karnataka, the state of my residence.

v. <u>Authorities issuing Identification documents.</u>

Attempts to use authorities issuing Identification documents, against me, is illogical and illegal. The ID is granted and is a yes or no result grant by the authority, and not for usage against me by bribe taking authority. Attempts to use respondent 4, for attempting 'Identity theft' and/or 'alias', with my name never reflected in the property receipts, however reflect 'Others', could also be used by US PTO by usage of exorbitant bribes.

- vi. <u>US PTO and rouge usa inciting colleges and universities</u> in India, to fight and kill each other.
 - US PTO possibly deployed and unleashed another negative tactic, in the name of 'competitive intelligence', to steal my work, and steal my wealth.
 - The negative tactic is 'inciting rage, inciting anger, in the name of competitive genius, and competitive intelligence', inciting all the universities, and colleges across India, to commit 'Identity theft', become an 'alias', and steal my work, and steal my wealth. This could include all universities across India, and all colleges across India.
 - With reference of and in accordance with PCT article 9(1), the Honorable court must dismiss attempts of all universities in India, and attempts of all colleges in India, attempting to become 'alias' for me to steal my work, and steal my wealth.
 - Colleges and universities must talk with their World Intellectual Property Organization publications, that have meaning, and are of certain value, and not destroy themselves with rouge usa negative tactics.
- 34. <u>In summary</u>, the Honorable court must enforce these legal statements, which are accepted facts across India, and World.
 - People, and parties connected with these legal agreements are plain simply bound by the contents of the legal agreements.
 - A legal agreement, or the legal instrument, cannot be used as a tool, mechanism, rouge method, or rouge approach to frame other parties in the agreement negatively.
 - Identification issued by an authority is for the receiving citizen.
 - Such Identification documents, ID'S cannot be used as a tool, mechanism, rouge method, or rouge approach to negatively frame the person the ID is issued for.
- 35. This Writ Petition must be connected with the case for execution of 62 sale agreements, one each with each of the 62 World countries where I have patent rights, listed in annexure S and described in detail in annexure T.

GROUNDS

- 36. The following are the grounds for the sought Prayer, including the Interim prayer orders.
 - The breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty articles 18(2) and 19(1), committed by US PTO, on 5-8-2015, for my Invention patent PCT/us2014/046619, is applicable, recognized by the Honorable court orders annexure A, the 'cause of action' to conclude by way of execution of 62 sale agreements described in annexure T.
 - Orders issued for WP 12356/2023, on date 14-6-2014, by the Honorable court recognizing the Breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty, are applicable, and these orders are attached annexure A.
 - PCT Preamble provision 'contribution to progress of science and technology...' is applicable, connected directly with achieving 'Goal year 2050 for India', also referred as 'Goal year 30 FE for India'. The contribution to 'Science and Technology', is integral for achieving 'Goal year 30 FE for India', and will span several sectors, technologies, science subjects, incubating 'Science and Technology Evolution Zones' across India.
 - PCT article 9(1) is applicable, by which I must receive the wealth from the 62 sale agreements into my bank account in India.
 - My Intended 'wealth distribution' according to annexure D. Article 51A of constitution of India is applicable, and I am performing my Fundamental Duties for my country and the majority religion of HINDUISM. My 'Invention systems and methods' including all sector Industrial applications, registered and granted in my name across 62 World countries, are the highest valued property in the World, my Intellectual property patent rights across 62 World countries, the wealth that I will receive in my bank account in INDIA. My responsible allocation of this wealth, that I will receive into my individual bank account in India, is indicated in annexure D, by which I am performing my 'Fundamental duties' according to article 51A of constitution of India. The recognized liability caused to US PTO, by patent territory, lost patent rights, with liability dates are listed in annexure B, and this is my recognized patent wealth and income, with patent an 'asset' in 'Intellectual property' asset class, directly connected with my tax filings from FY 2020-2021 and after.

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- CPC section 151 is applicable. The Honorable court must exercise CPC section 151, if required, and necessary, for granting the interim prayer orders, and prayer orders.

For aforesaid reasons, the Honorable court must grant the Interim prayer orders, and prayer orders immediately, and connect this Writ Petition with the case for execution of 62 sale agreements in this Honorable court, kept in Pending, Adjourned status.

- 37. There is urgency for receiving 'Interim prayer' orders.
 - The GST registration certificate must accurately reflect my information, and must be activated immediately by the Honorable court orders. Further, it should be kept in active status and never deactivated with reference of this Writ Petition, connected to the case for execution of 62 sale agreements, so that the lessee can remit the lease rental proceeds. This will enable the lessee to pay the pending lease rental proceeds, and continue to pay the rent according to annexure K. Hence, there is urgency in receiving these orders.
 - For ensuring no negative tactics of 'Identity theft', or 'usage of alias', for fraudulently claiming my work, and claiming my wealth, there is urgency in issuing orders for respondent 4, to issue 'property tax' paid receipts with my name included, and reflected accurately.

PRAYER

38. With reference to orders issued by the Honorable court for Writ Petition WP 12356/2023, dated 14-6-2024, attached annexure A, and the legal resolution of the recognized 'cause of action', the Breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty committed by 'united states patent and trademark office', US PTO, by way of execution of 62 sale agreements described in detail in annexure T, the caused liability to US PTO in Trillions of EARTHLINGS, liability caused by patent territory, lost patent rights with liability caused dates listed in annexure B, full value payable into my individual bank account in INDIA according to PCT article 9(1), and with reference of my responsibly and legally pledged 'wealth allocation' according to annexure D, by 'granted patent 'us 8,910,998 B1', and PCT/us2014/046619, combined with all other sector Industrial

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applications, sale price valuation', caused liability to US PTO, my recognized patent wealth and income connected with my tax filings, the Honorable court must issue the following orders to,

- A. Respondent 2, to allow the deferred payment of the pending due 'Income tax' for Financial years FY 2020-2021 and after, payable by me, to the Income tax department, until after the execution of all the 62 sale agreements, described in annexure T.
- B. Respondent 2, to apply according to rules, applicable fees, charges, penalties, and interest for the pending due 'Income tax' payable by me, submit a record for the Honorable court, annually, and offset the cumulated due amount, against my payment of the first check to the 'commissioner of Income tax department' according to annexure D.
- C. Respondent 2, upon the receipt of the first check paid by me according to annexure D, and received by them, also offsetting all my pending due income tax, to issue an official written communication, that I have paid all pending income tax dues, upto the current financial year of applicable income tax.
- D. Respondent 3, to allow the deferred payment of all the pending due 'Goods and Services Tax, GST' for my lease rental deposits according to annexure K, payable by me, to them, until after the execution of all the 62 sale agreements, described in annexure T.
- E. Respondent 3, to apply according to rules, applicable fees, charges, penalties, and interest for the pending due 'Goods and Services Tax, GST' for my lease rental deposits according to annexure K, payable by me, submit a record for the Honorable court, annually, and offset the cumulated due amount, against my payment of the first check to the 'commissioner of Income tax department' according to annexure D.
- F. Respondent 3, upon the receipt of the first check paid by me, to the 'commissioner of Income tax department' according to annexure D, offsetting all the pending due 'Goods and Services Tax, GST', to issue an official communication, that I have paid all pending GST dues up to the current financial year.

- G. Respondent 1, be accessible for any questions that respondent 2, respondent 3, or respondent 4 might have about "Breach of Patent Cooperation Treaty' committed by 'us pto", recognized by the Honorable court orders, attached court orders, annexure A.
- H. With reference of this Writ petition 'Neutralizing and terminating negative tactics' section, with US PTO and their allies attempting 'Identity theft', and using 'aliases for stealing my work and stealing my wealth', Honorable court must issue orders to dismiss and terminate such illegal negative tactics, if they come to recognize such negative tactics, or become aware of usage of such negative tactics. In the most despicable negative tactics, US PTO and allies are attempting to use 'Legal agreements as a tool to attack and frame a person' and use parties in the legal agreements to frame one of the parties, me, negatively, and claim 'Identity', which is 'Identity theft', and 'become an alias for me, attempting to steal my wealth, and steal my work'. Further, US PTO and allies are attempting to use 'Identification issuing authorities' to frame me negatively, 'distort the Identity', which supports 'Identity theft', and 'enable creating an alias for me, attempting to steal my wealth, and steal my work'.

Honorable court must issue orders to dismiss and terminate such illegal negative tactics, attempted at World level, and within INDIA, if they come to recognize such negative tactics, or become aware of usage of such negative tactics. This will allow me, allow us to move into the stage of execution of 62 sale agreements described in detail in annexure T.

INTERIM PRAYER

With reference to urgency of 'continuously receiving the monthly lease rental deposit income, without interruptions', immediately enabling the lessee in annexure K to remit rent, remit the past rental dues, and continue to remit the rent, the Honorable court must issue the following orders immediately to,

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- I. Respondent 3, for terminating attempts of 'Identity theft', or creating 'aliases' for taking credit of my work, and for stealing my wealth, record my identification accurately, must correct my address in the 'Goods and Services Taxes, GST' registration certificate, attached annexure G, and issue a new GST registration certificate with the same GST number, with address reflecting my address, accurately indicated in annexure F. While issuing the correct GST registration certificate, respondent 3 to correct the field 'Name Of Premises/Building'.
- J. Respondent 3, to keep my 'Goods and Services Taxes, GST' registration number active, allowing financial transactions, payment of lease rental dues and lease rental deposits, by the lessee occupying the leased premises according to annexure K, until the conclusion of the execution of 62 sale agreements described in annexure T. The lessee cannot process rental remittance payments if the GST number is deactivated, or invalidated, with the requested deferment of GST pending dues, according to this Writ Petition, and with reference of annexure D contributions for respondent 2, and States of India.
- K. Respondent 4, for terminating attempts of 'Identity theft', or creating 'aliases' for taking credit of my work, and for stealing my wealth, record my identification accurately, must correctly reflect my name in the property tax paid receipts, replacing the word 'Others', by 'Srinivas. D. S.', including and accurately reflecting my name in the receipts. This is with reference to attached annexure P, one of the incorrectly issued past receipts.

Technical details about implementation of my patent 'Inventive Systems and Methods', for Industrial application, for Construction industry, delivering the required 'Thermal Insulation' for homes, offices, Industrial, and other buildings, delivering energy savings of estimated 75%, in the block of next 100 years.

For countries that experience extreme cold climatic conditions. With reference of PCT/IB2016/050994 filing date of 24-2-2016, considering a block of 100 years for energy cost computations, the following must be understood. The Energy savings realized are forever, while business and patent sale price calculations are computed by a block of 100 years.

The single or multi layer system, is attached on the outside of the building, with Thermal Insulation material filled into the fluid 208

tight space, must be read as 'Insulation material space'. The system could have more layers for color of the wall requirements, and other alternate design of multi layers system, and the implementation design options could be several, example, drilling minute apertures transmitting more heat into the building, home, office, industrial, or other, in one of the design implementation embodiments. The lab simulated tests, scaled up for volume of air in the house, office, Industrial, or other building include,

- Maintaining the air temperature close to the wall inside, at an estimated 20-22 degree celsius.

The lab simulated tests, scaled up for

volume of air in the house, office, Industrial, or other building include,

- Maintaining the air temperature close to the wall inside, at an estimated 27-30 degree celsius.
- Running the cooler inside the building simply delivering comfortable living air conditioning conditions, ambient temperature of 22-24 degree celsius.
- If not for the Inventive system installation, every second, of every minute, of every day, of every year, for next 91 years, the cooler is run, to deliver cold air into the building, with differential of external outside temperature ranging, varying across year, between 36, 45, 50, 55 degree celsius, to the comfortable living inside ambient target temperature of 22-24 degree celsius. The system with Thermal Insulation material, the cooler must deliver cold air into the building, to deliver the differential between the surface of the building temperature 27-30 degrees to the comfortable living inside ambient target temperature of 22-24 degree celsius.
